Carlos Correa, a national of Argentina, is currently Director of the Center for Interdisciplinary Studies on Industrial Property and Economics Law (CEIDIE), Director of the Master Program on Science and Technology Policy and Management, and of the Post-graduate Course on Intellectual Property of the University of Buenos Aires (UBA).

A lawyer and an economist, he obtained his Ph.D. degree from the University of Buenos Aires. His areas of expertise are investment, development and technology transfer, intellectual property, and competition policy law.

Professor Correa is a Member of the Commission on Intellectual Property Rights established by the Department for International Cooperation of the UK government. He has been Consultant to UNDP, UNCTAD, UNIDO, WHO, FAO, Inter-american Development Bank, INTAL, World Bank, SELA, ECLA, WHO, and other regional and international organizations.

He is also author of several books and articles on technology and intellectual property. Some notable contributions on intellectual property and genetic resources are: 1) "People, plants and patents.
